Your local Audubon Society is providing grants of up to \$300! The grants are available to be used for environmental education programs and projects in the Central Wisconsin Region including Portage, Wood, Marathon and Waupaca counties.

Audubon's mission is to conserve and restore natural ecosystems, focusing on birds, other wildlife, and their habitats for the benefit of humanity and the earth's biological diversity.

Grant proposals will be evaluated by the ALAS Board of directors. All grants submitted will be considered based on the merit of the proposal.

Please send a 1-2 page letter describing your project or program. Explain how the goals of your project address Audubon's mission and focus. Identify your audience and the approximate number of youth and adults your project will get involved. Projects will need to be completed within a year's time. Include a date for when funds will be needed and a budget.

Each awarded grantee will be required to submit a final project summary report to ALAS approximately one year after the grant is awarded in order to be considered for future grants. Please include at least 2 photos that document your project.
